The ornamental design for a universal pneumatic swivel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a universal pneumatic swivel, showing my new design, the bottom being a mirror image of the top shown;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.

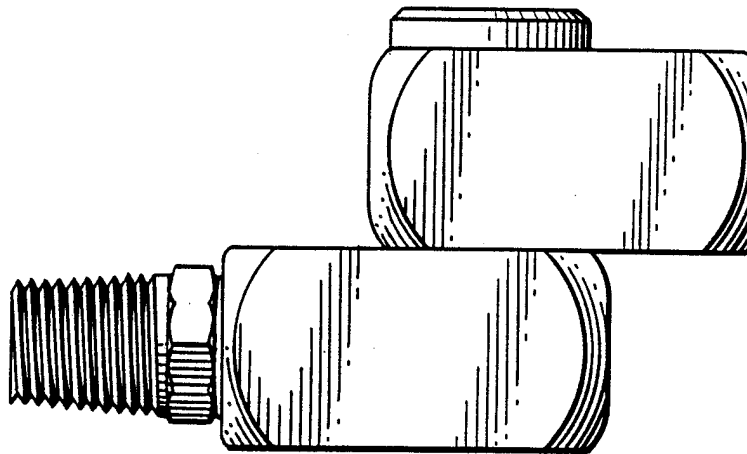

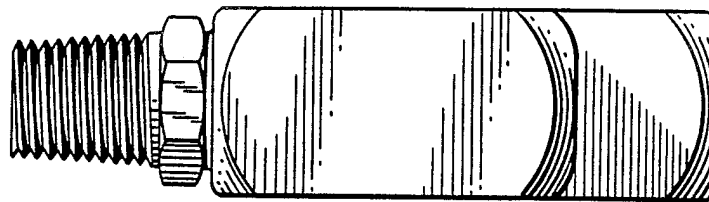

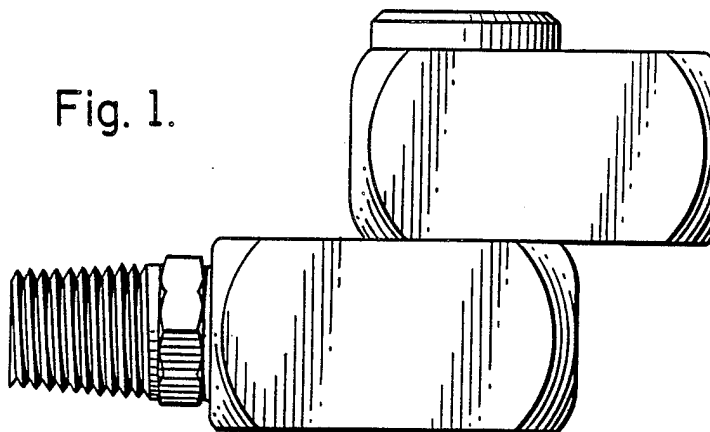

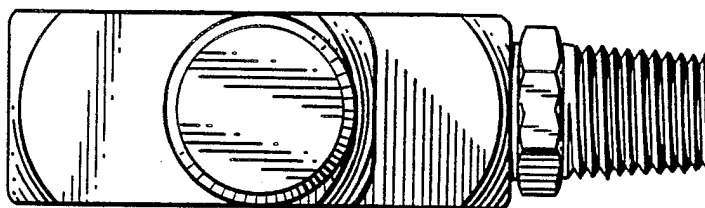

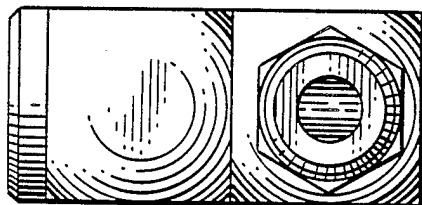
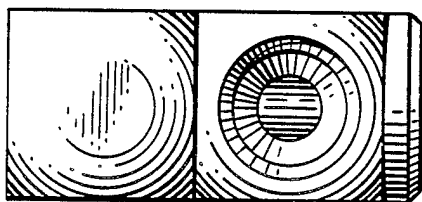
