FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

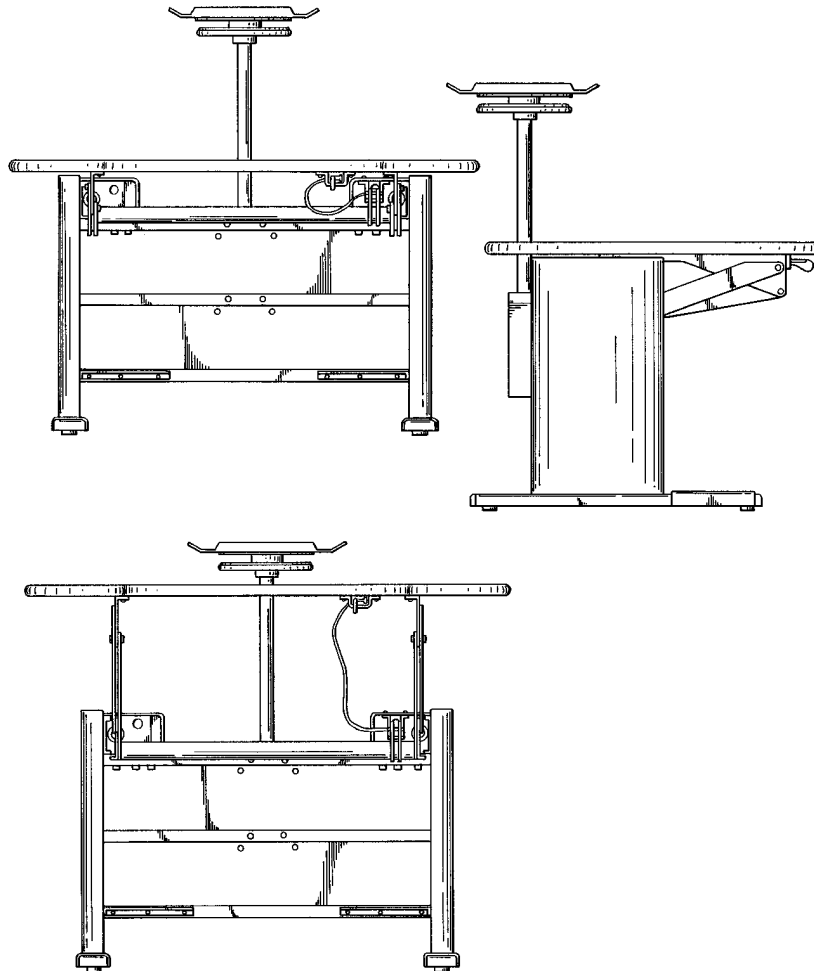
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof;

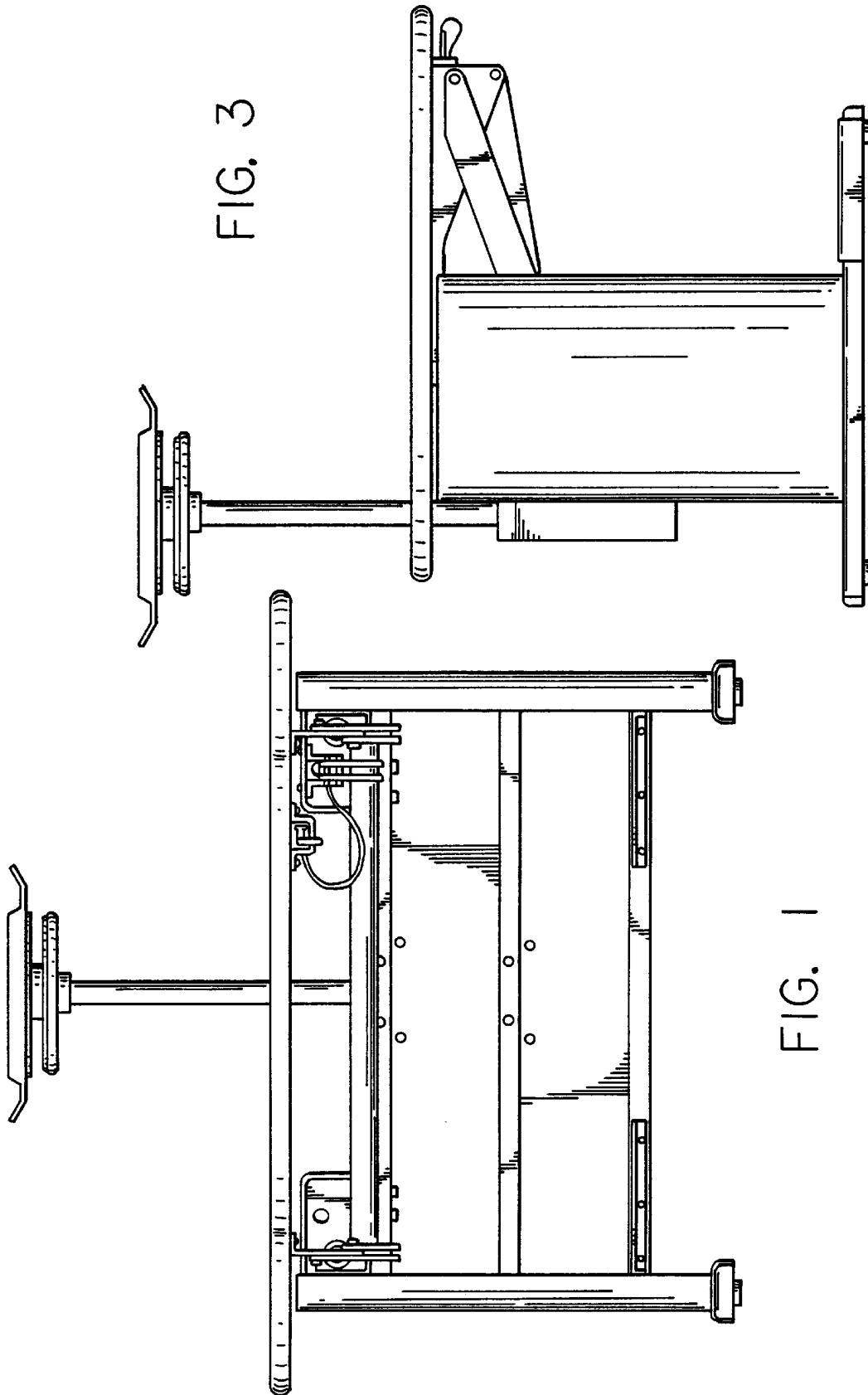
FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,

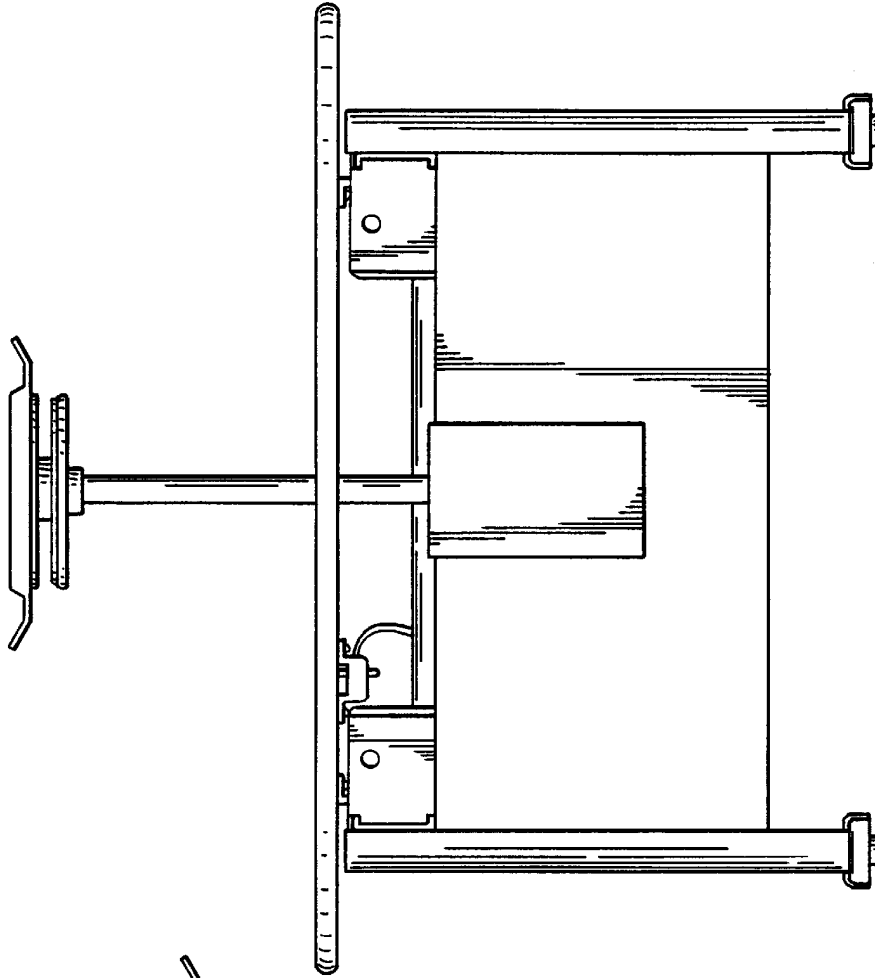

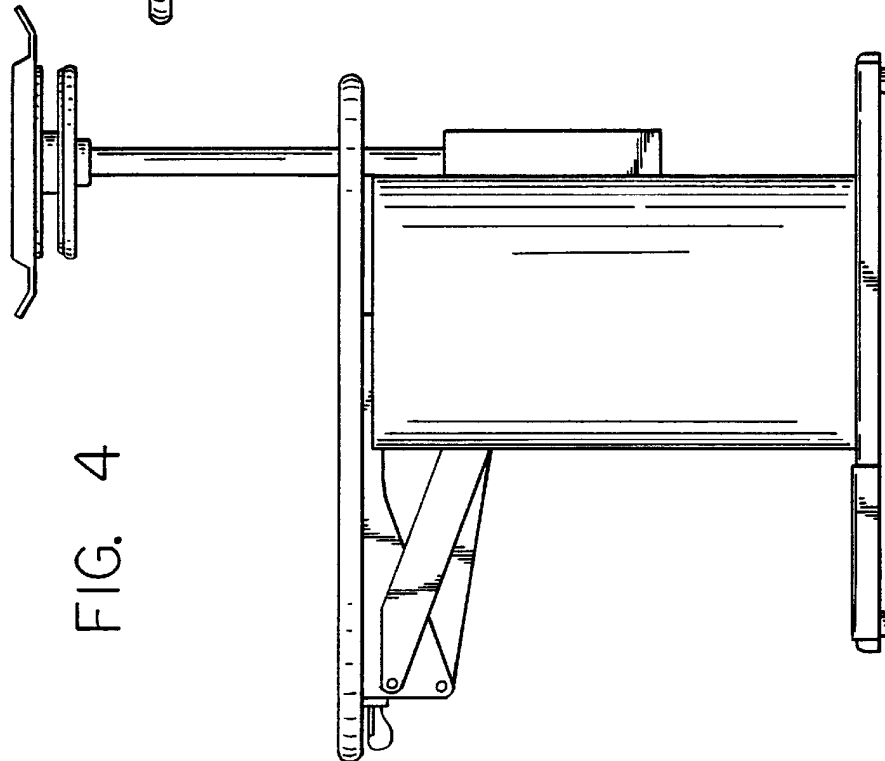

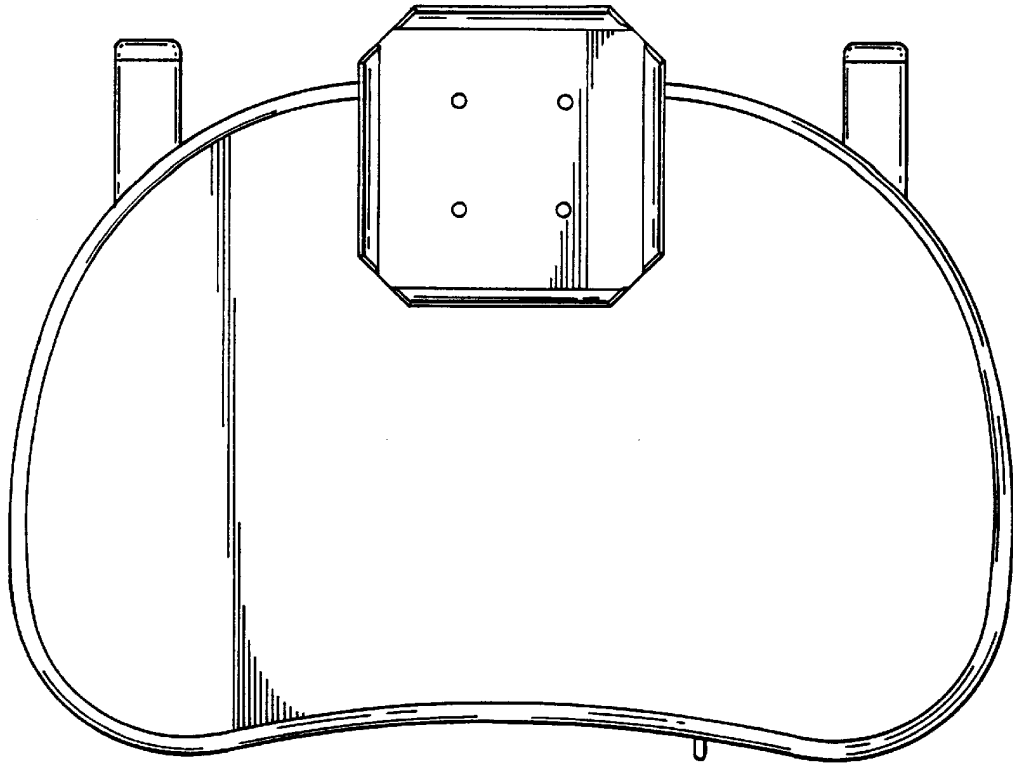

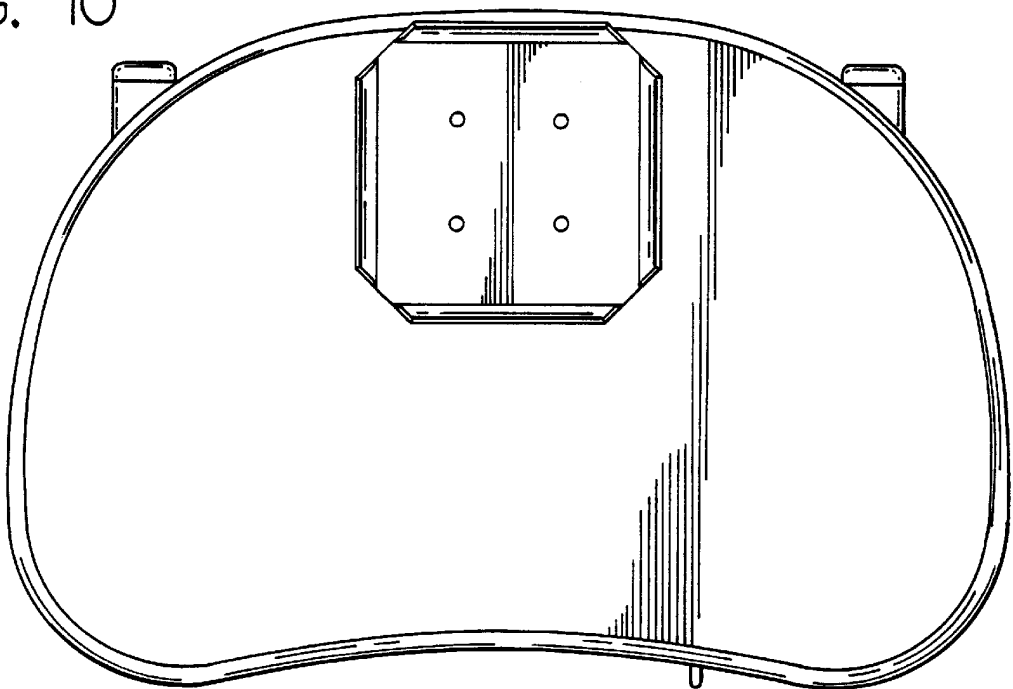

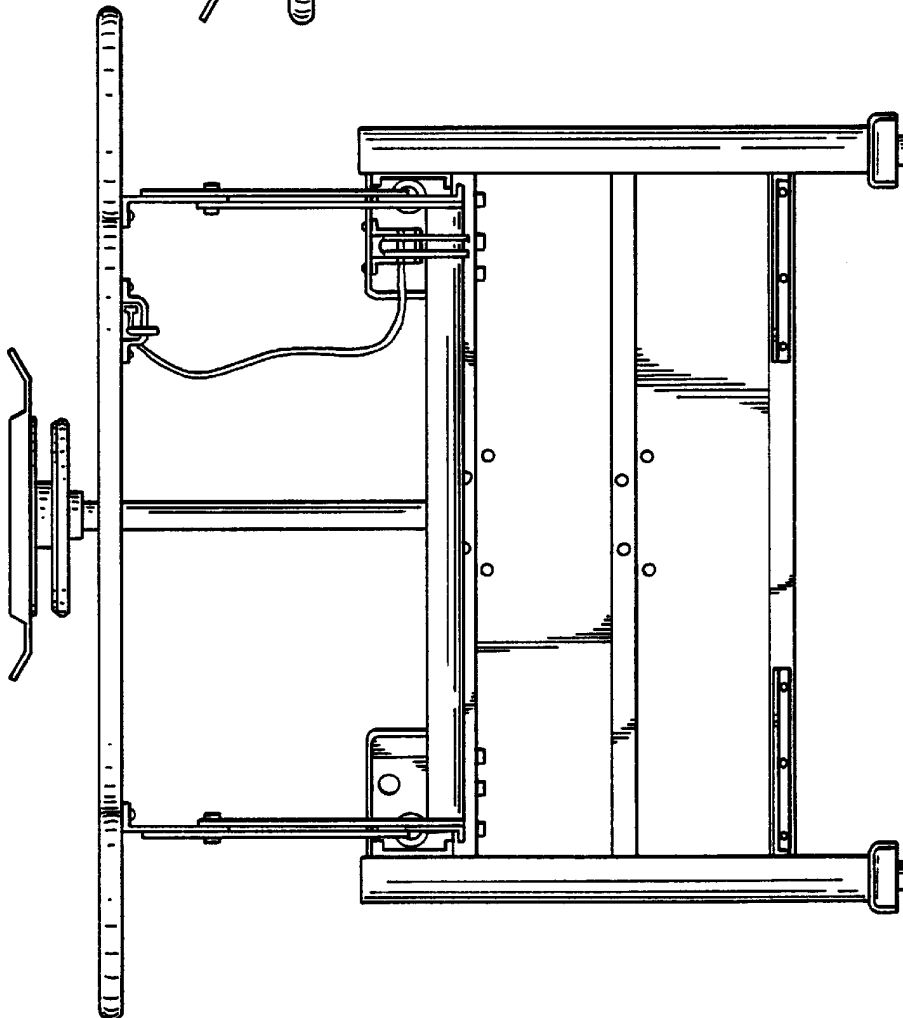
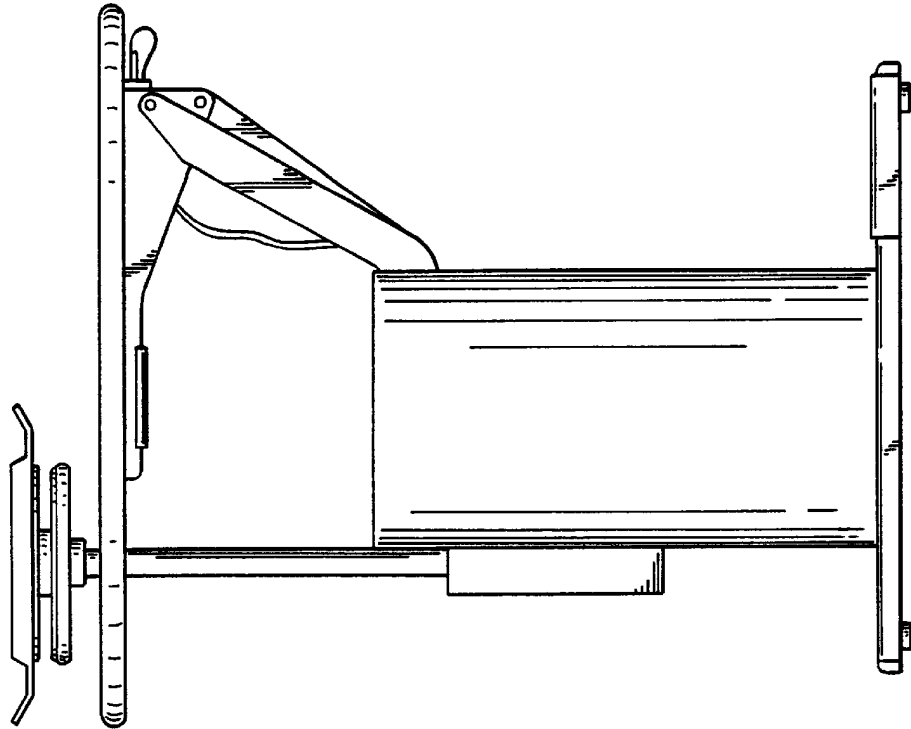

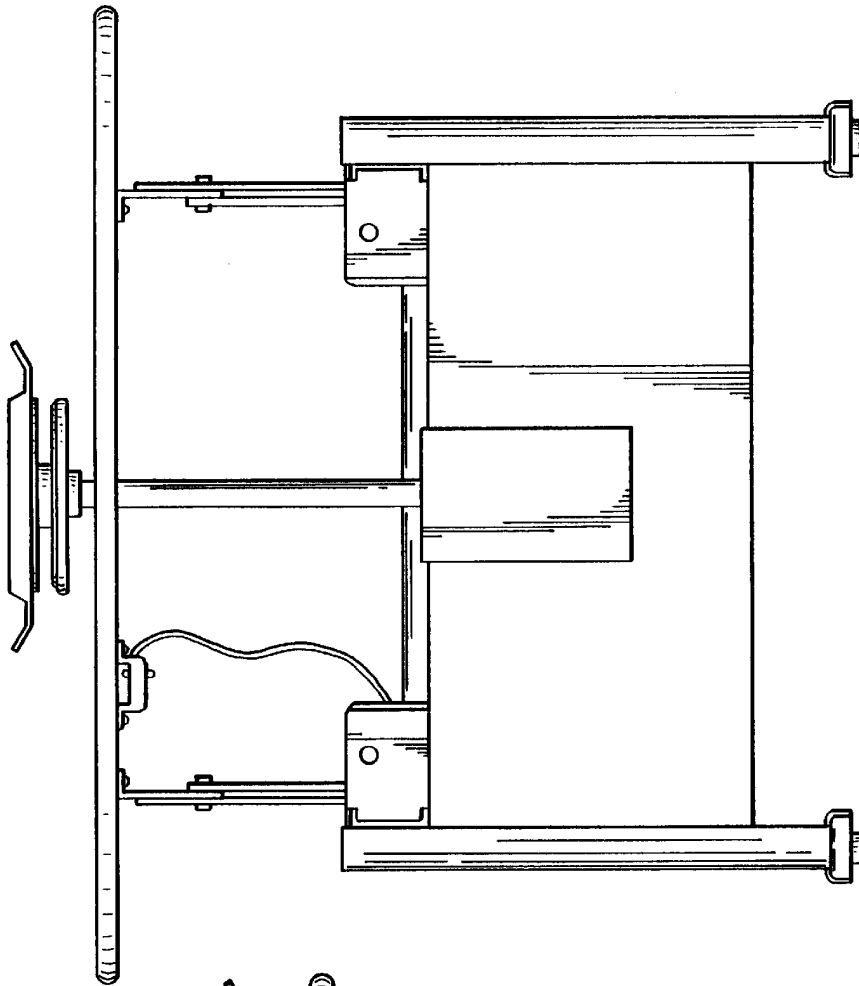

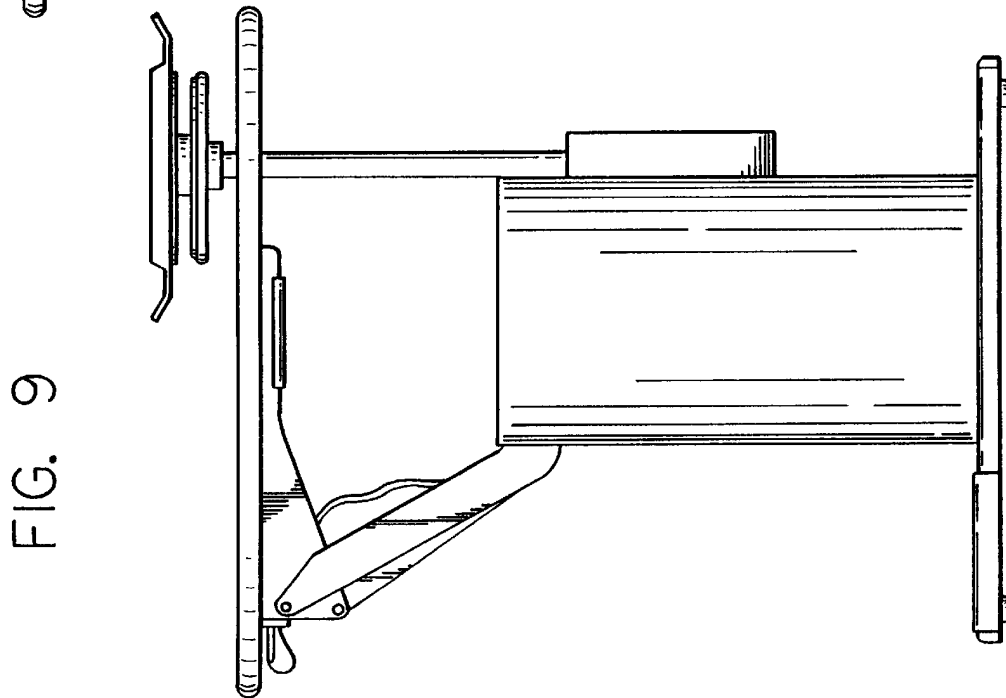
