FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the present invention;

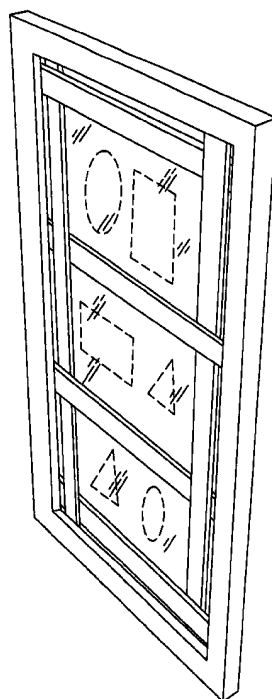
FIG. 6 is a right side view of the present invention; and,

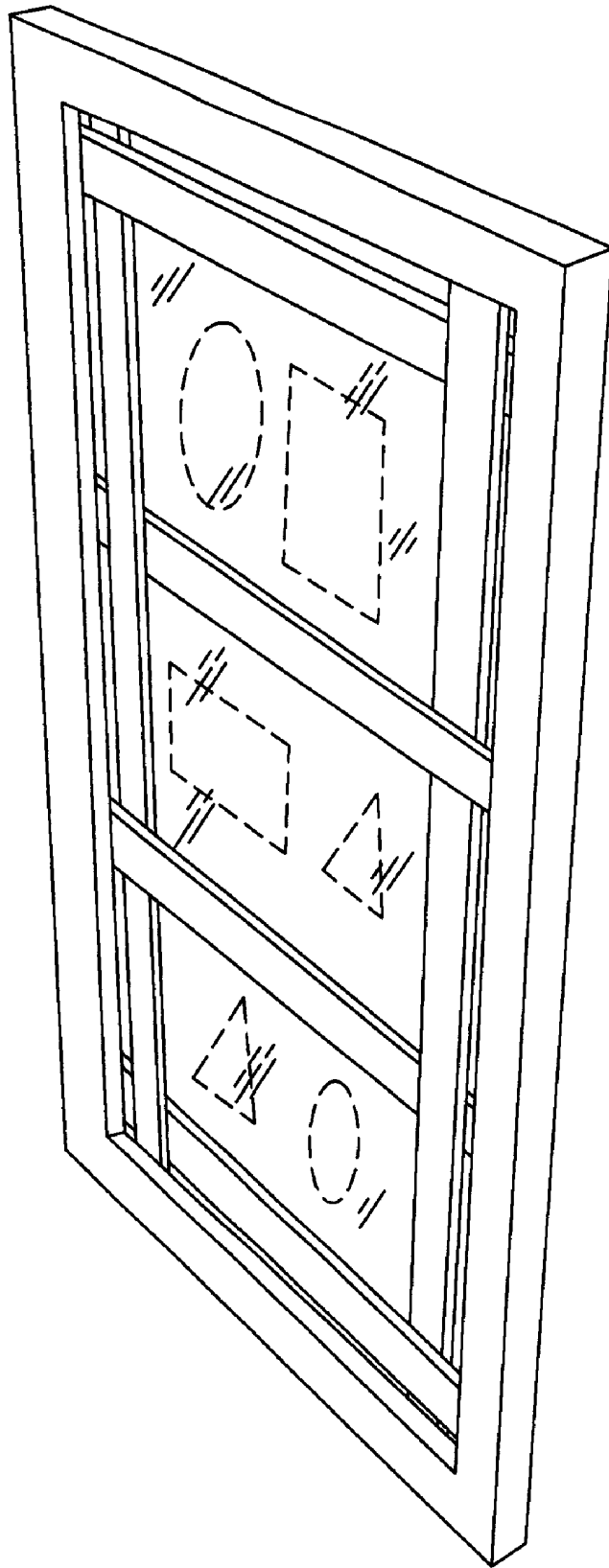

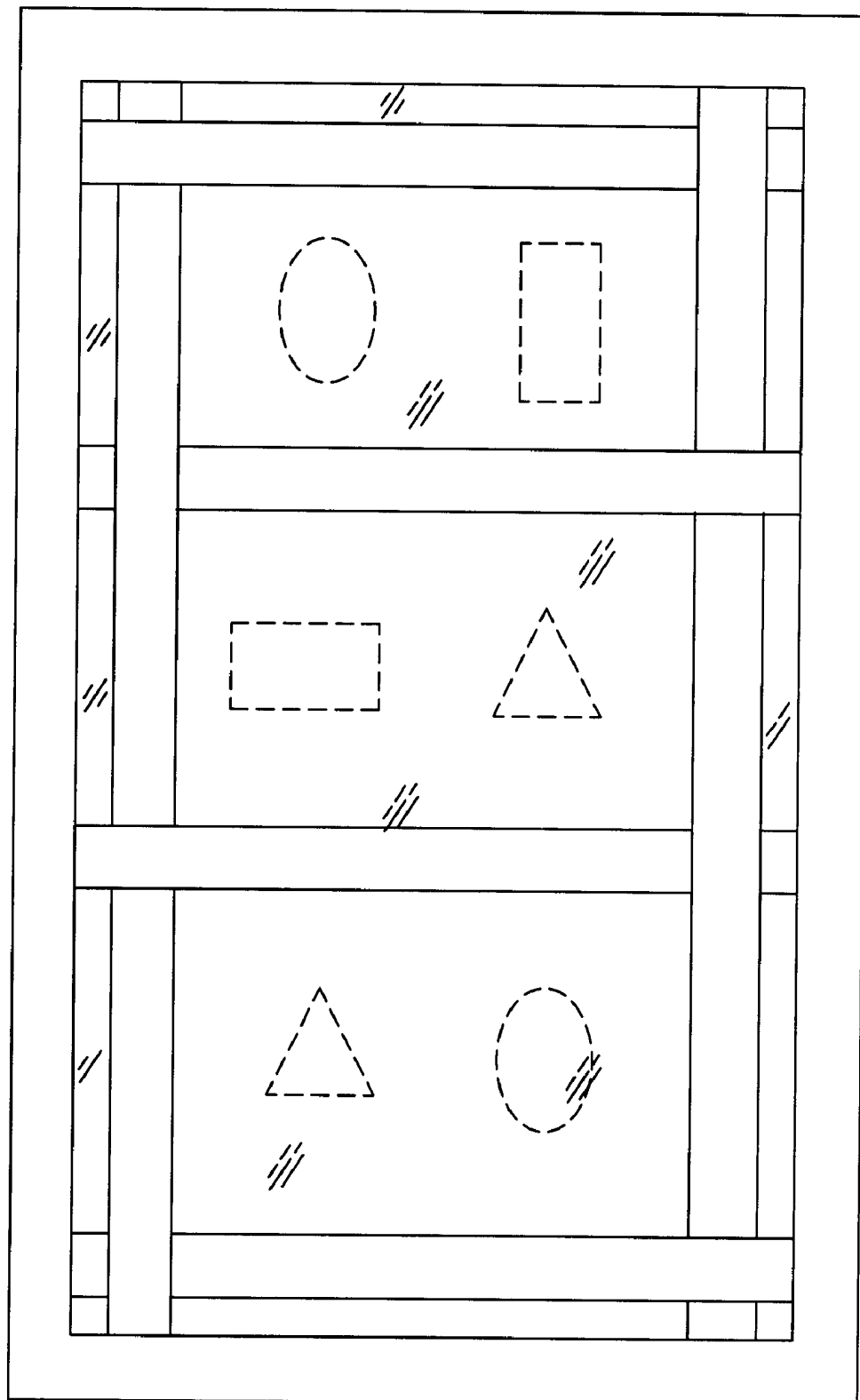

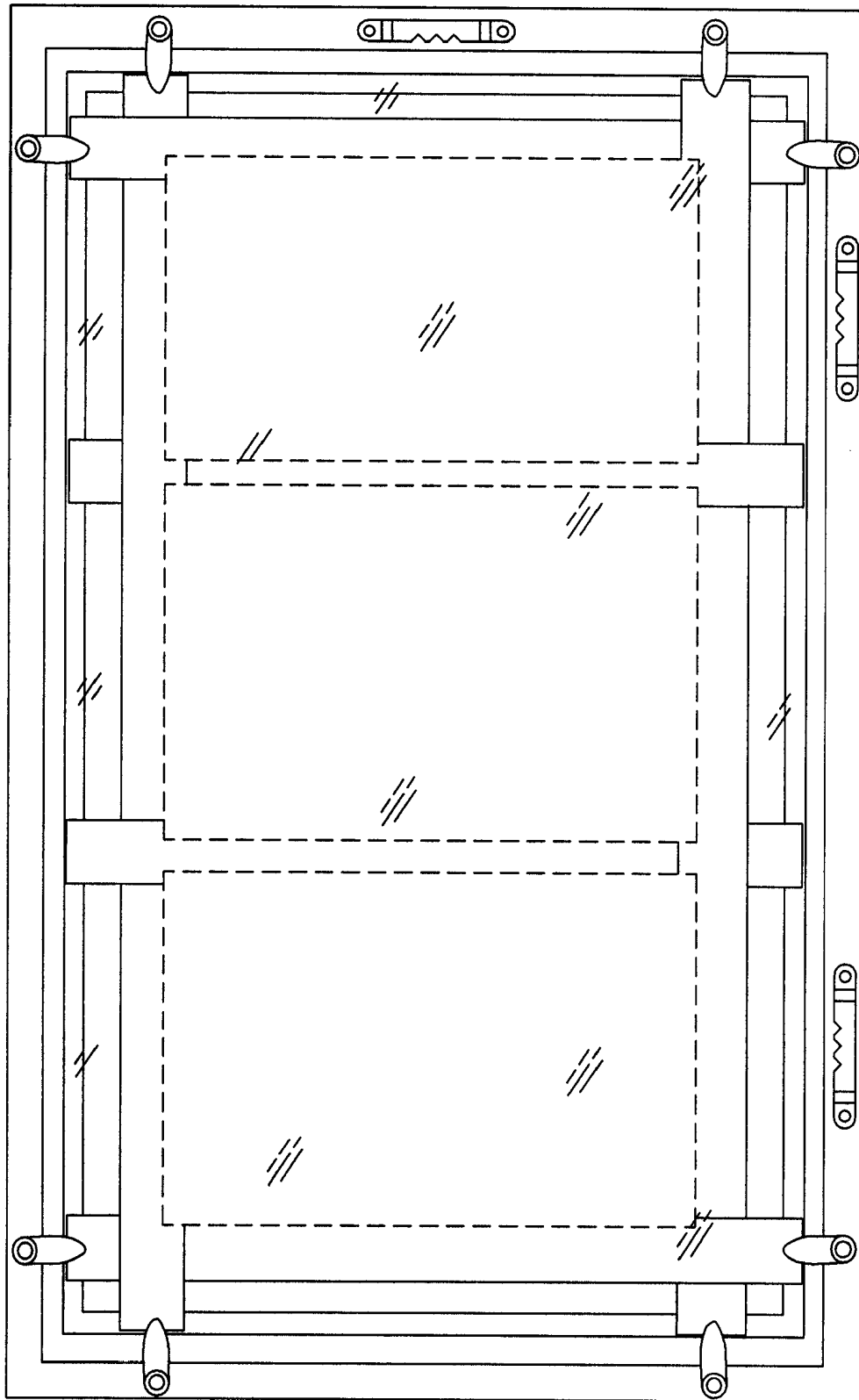

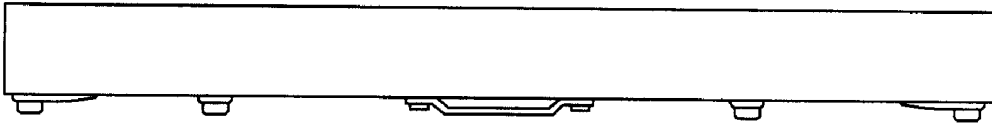

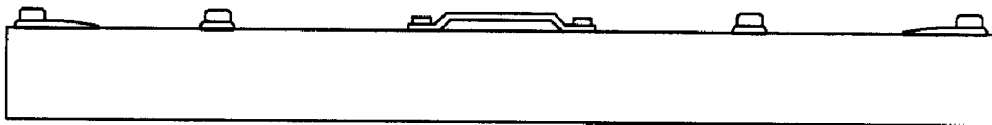

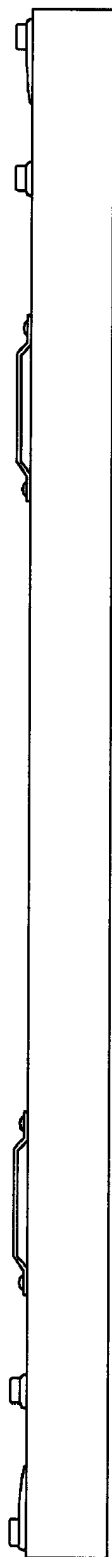
