FIG. 3 is a rear view of the invention shown in FIG. 1;

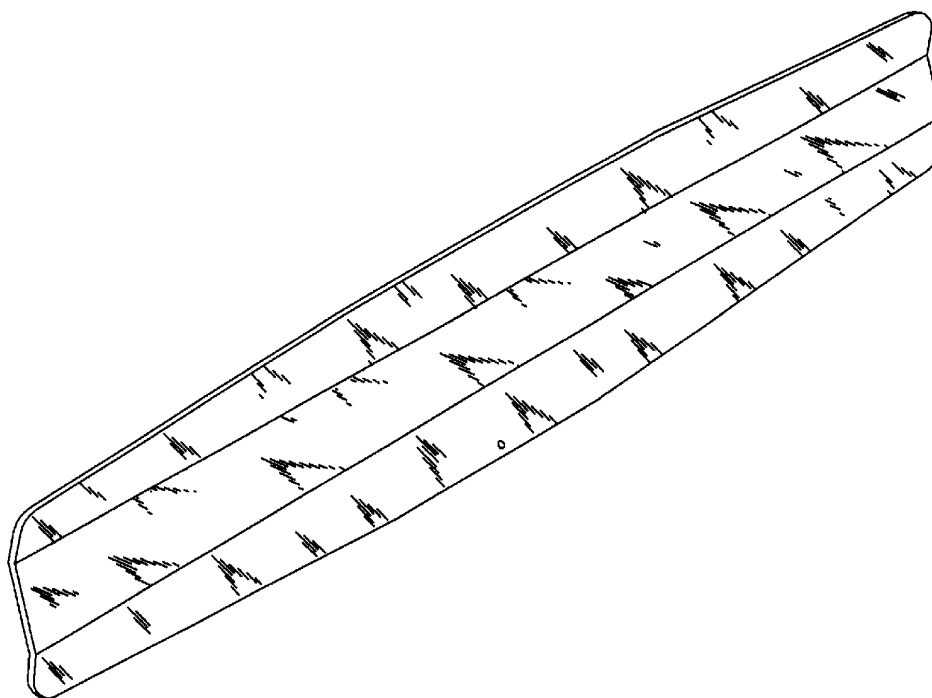
FIG. 4 is an end view of the invention taken from the left side as viewed in FIG. 1;

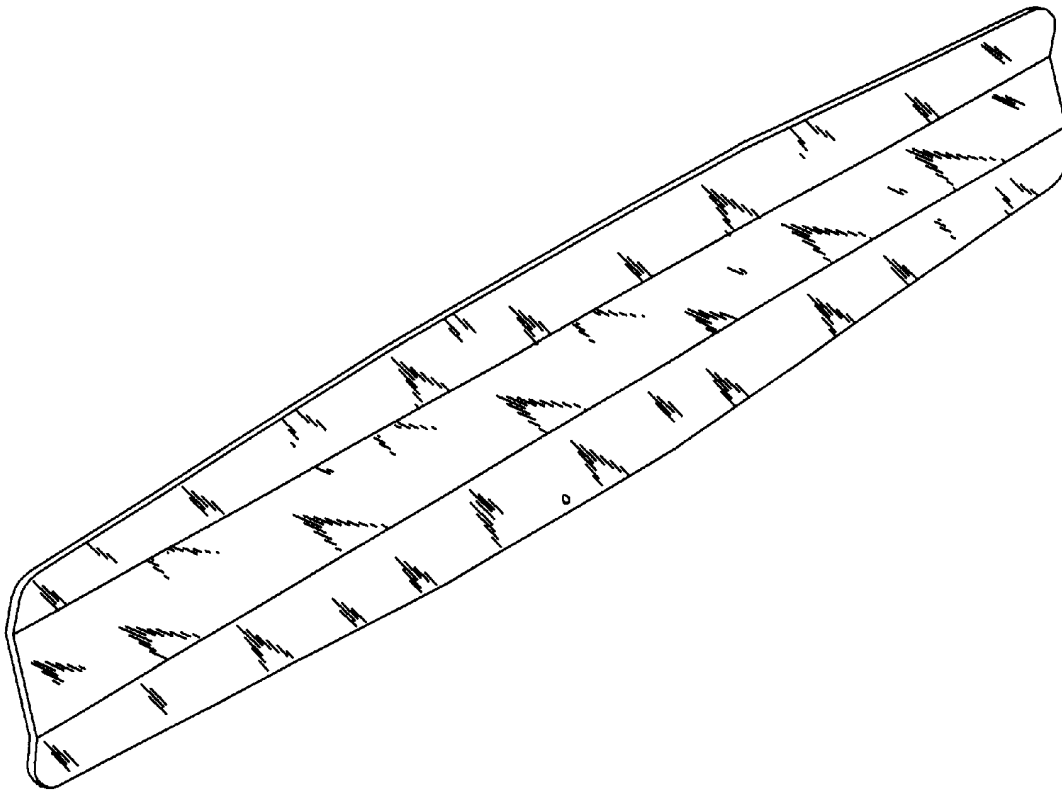

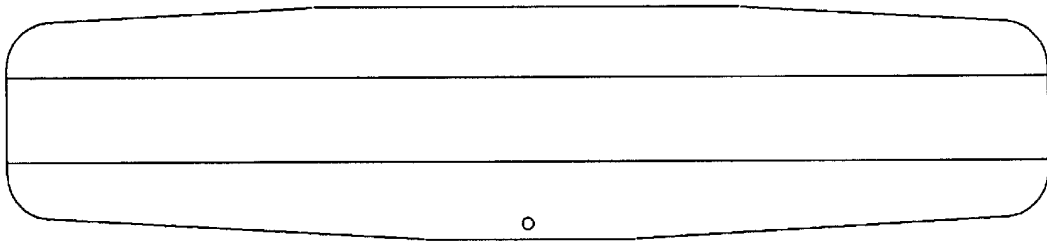

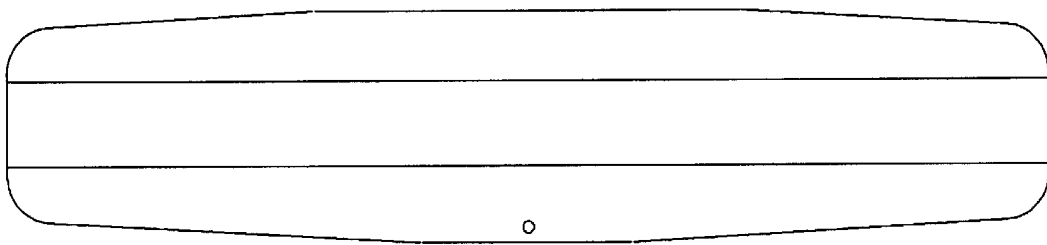

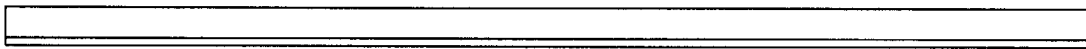

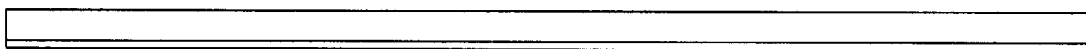
