FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the toy element;

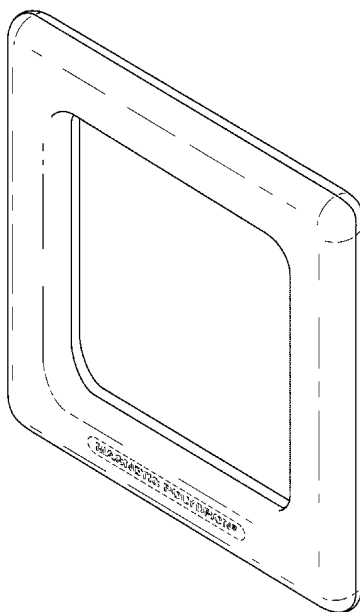
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the toy element;

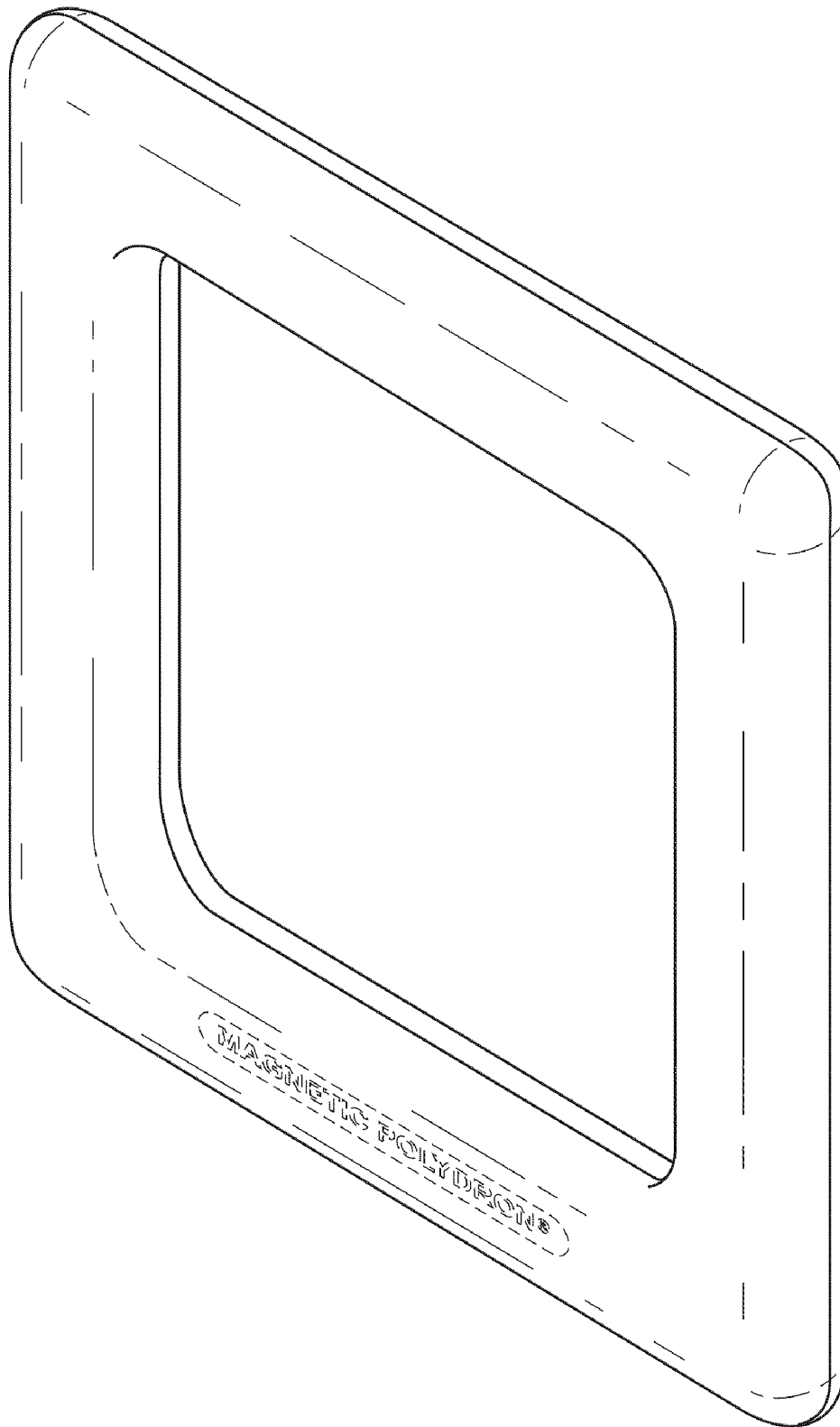

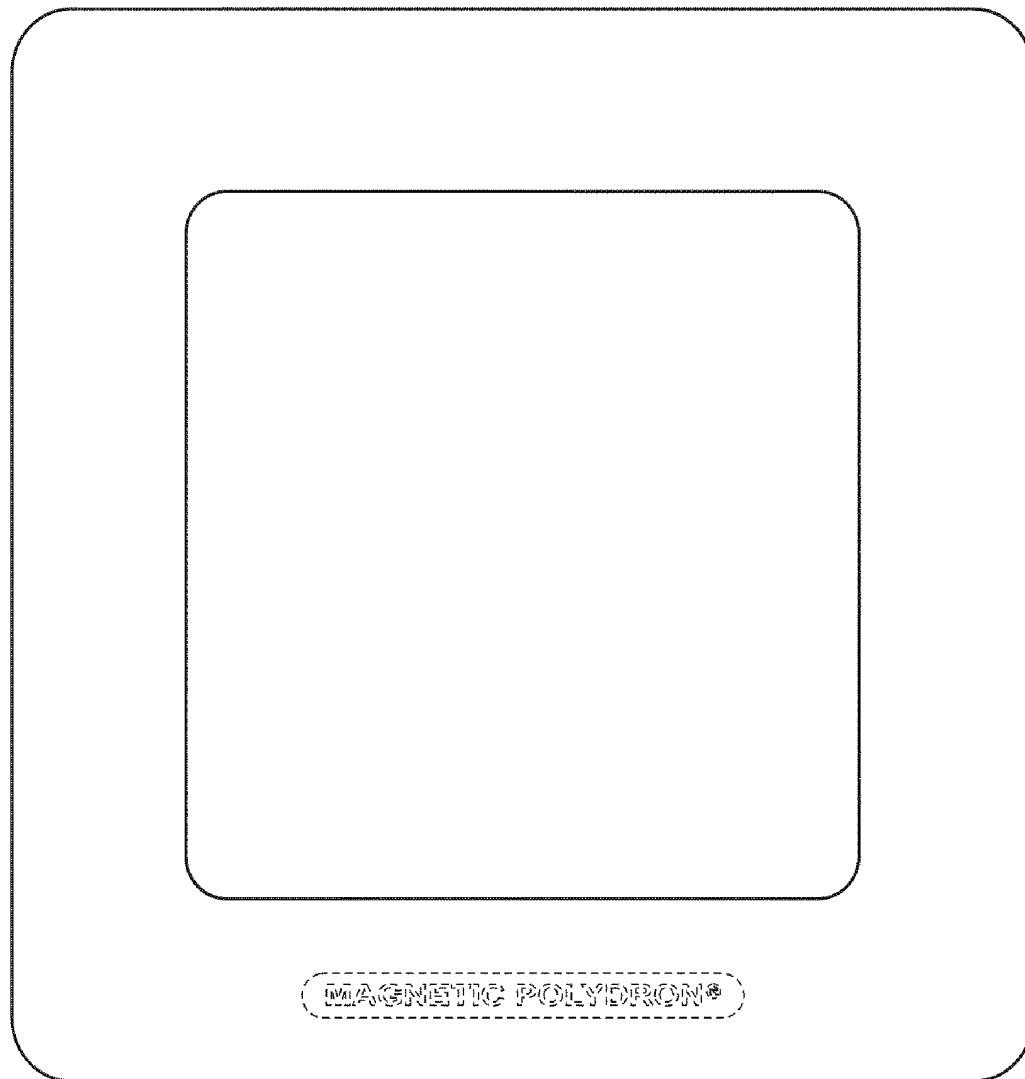

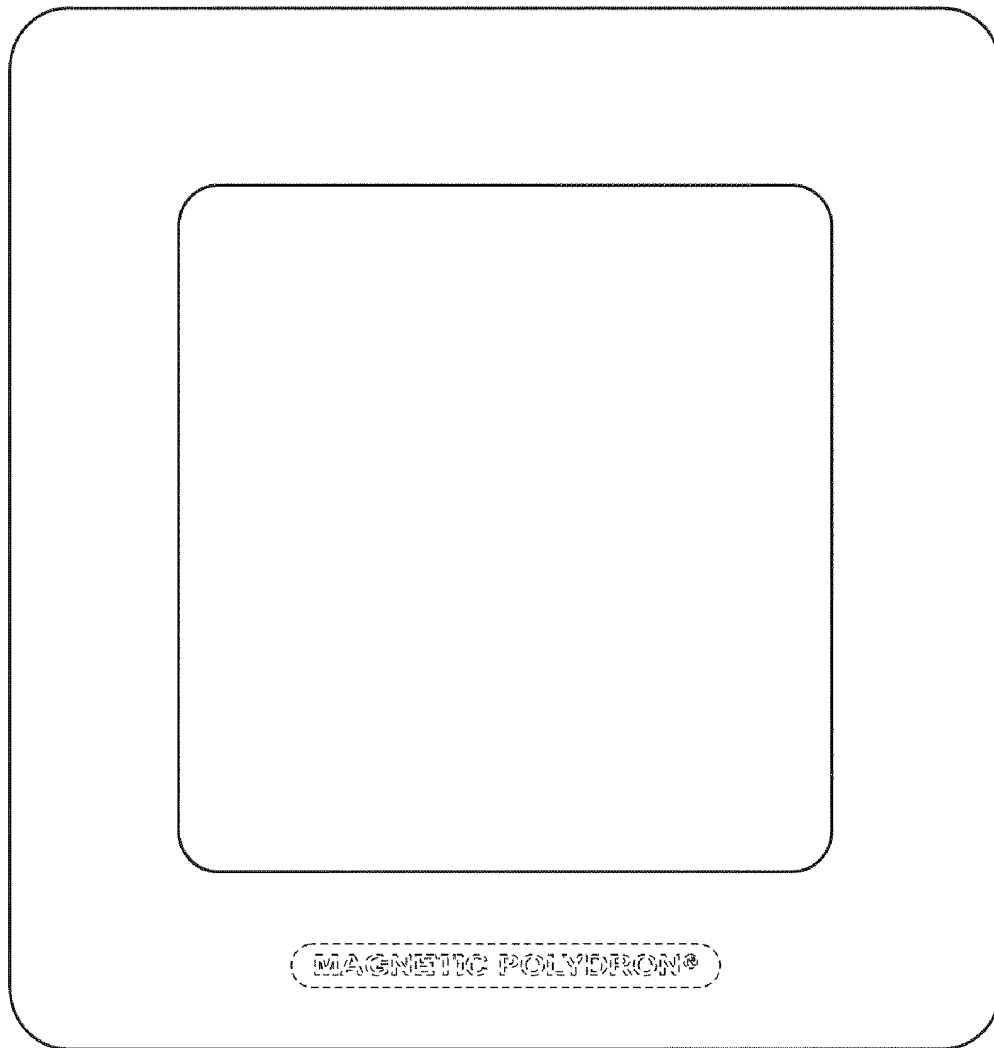

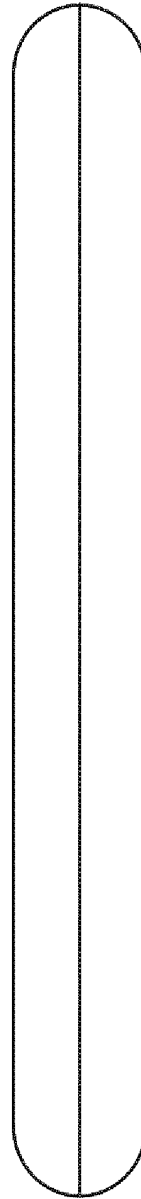
