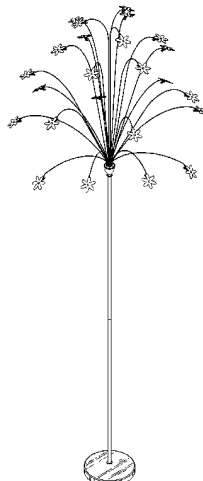

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the floral photograph holder; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the floral photograph holder; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the floral photograph holder; FIG. 4 is a left elevational view of the floral photograph holder; FIG. 5 is a right elevational view of the floral photograph holder; FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the floral photograph holder; FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the floral photograph holder; FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of one of the individual petals of the floral photograph holder; and, FIG. 9 is a top perspective view of one of the individual petals of the floral photograph holder. The views shown in FIGS. 8 and 9 are identical for each of the petals in the claimed floral photograph holder of the present invention.

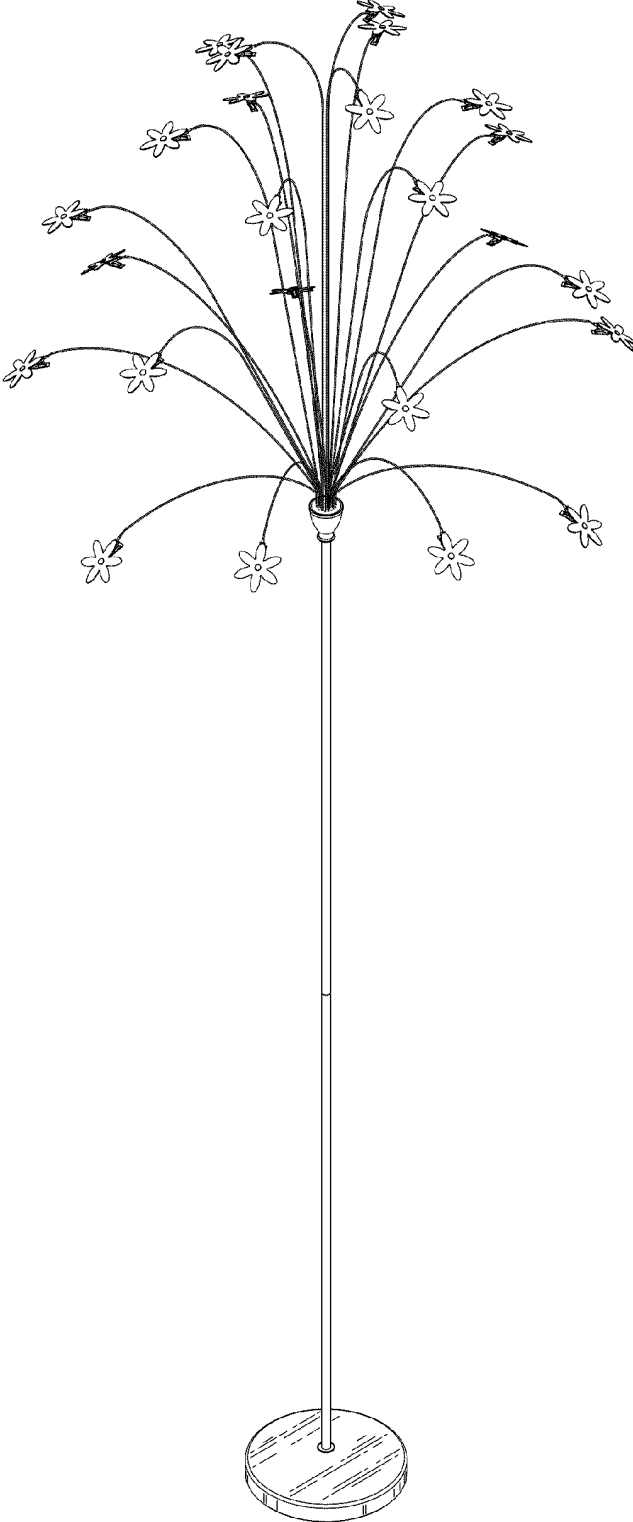

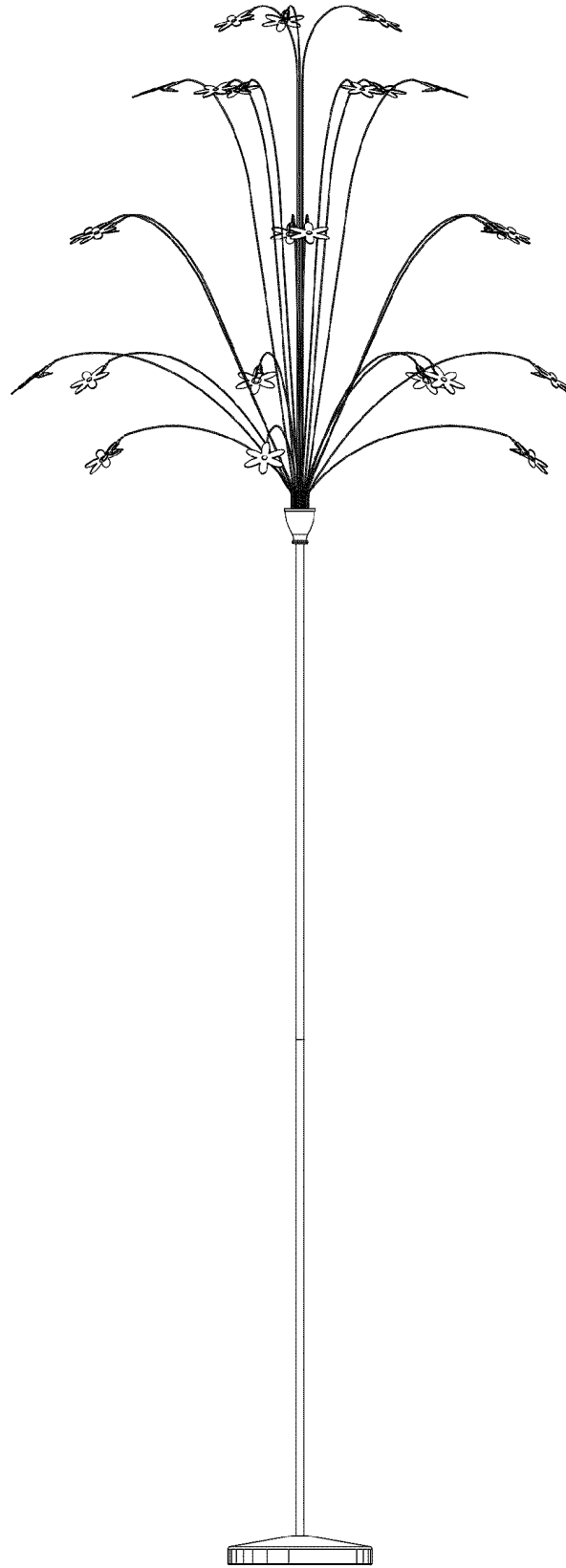

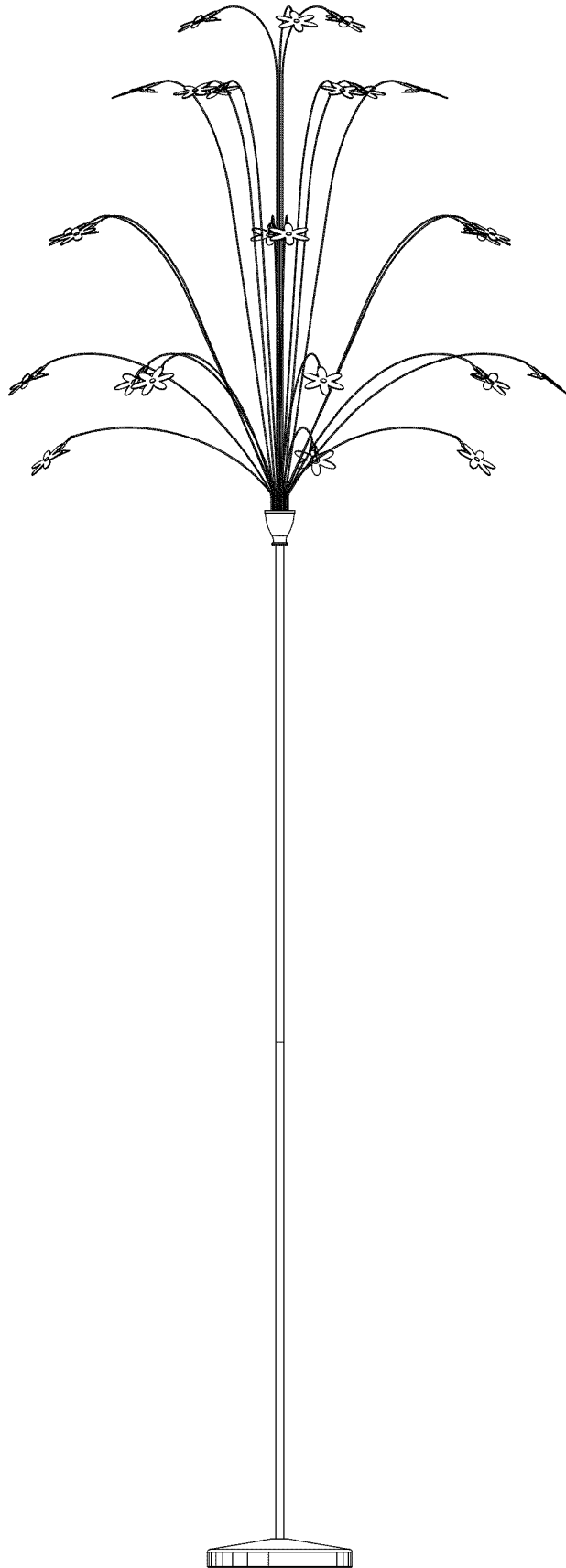

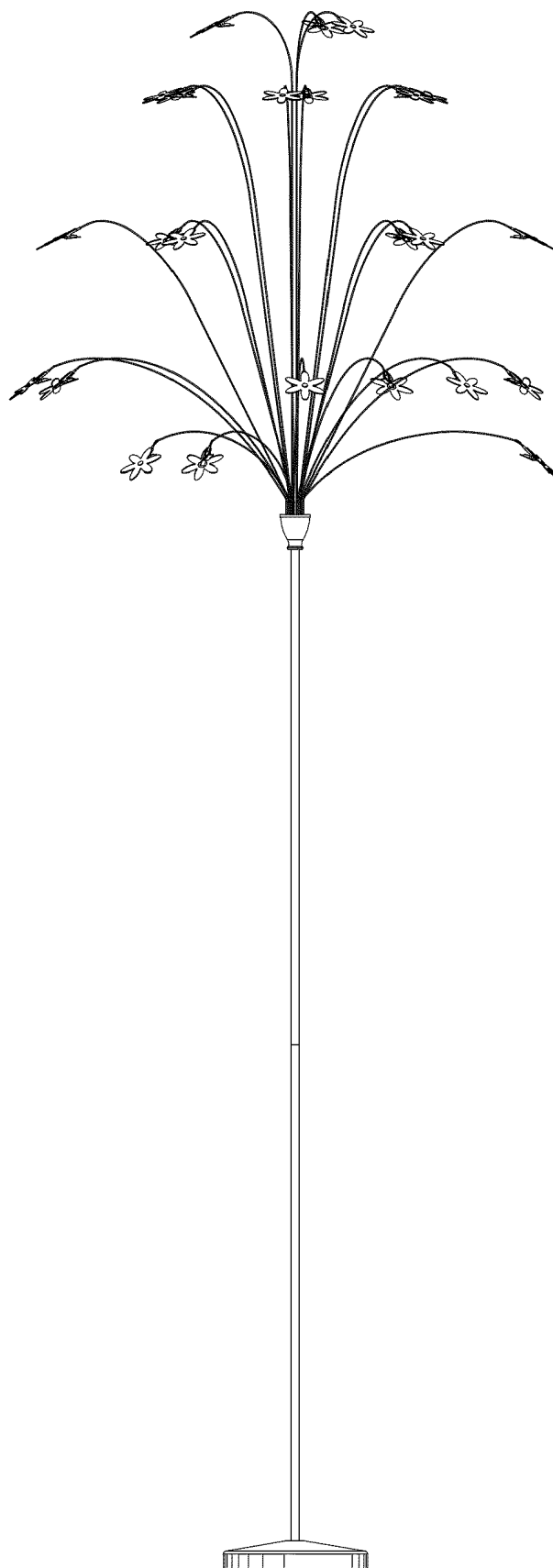

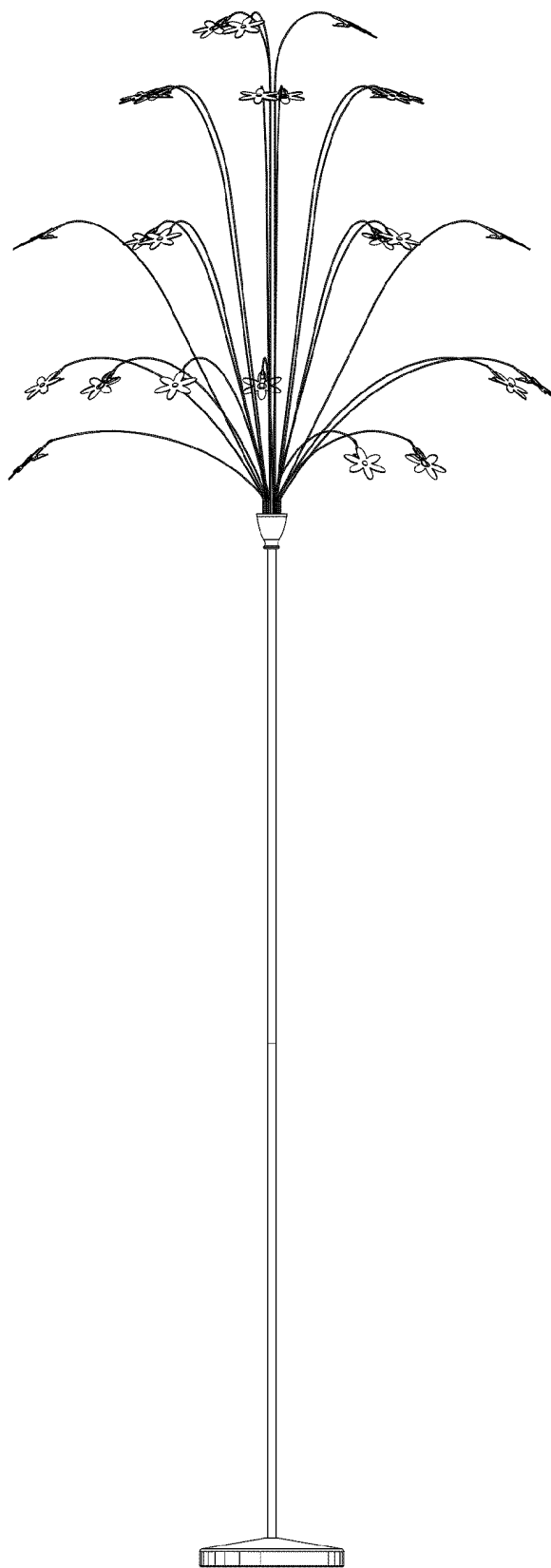

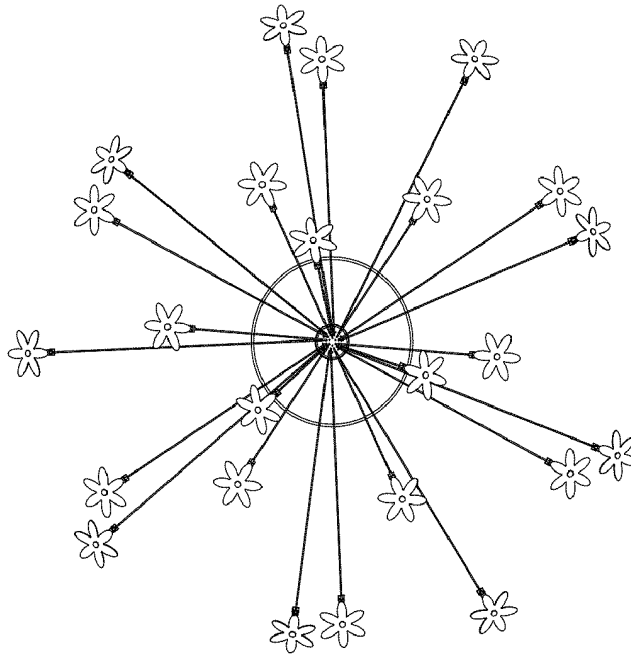

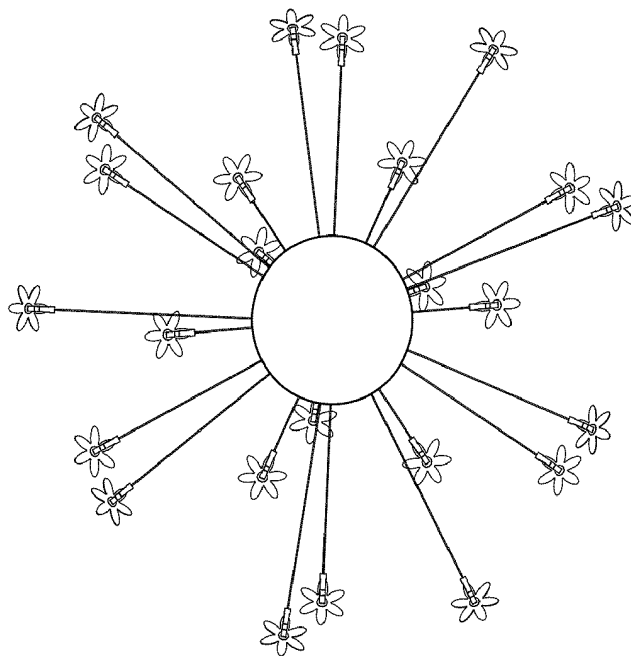

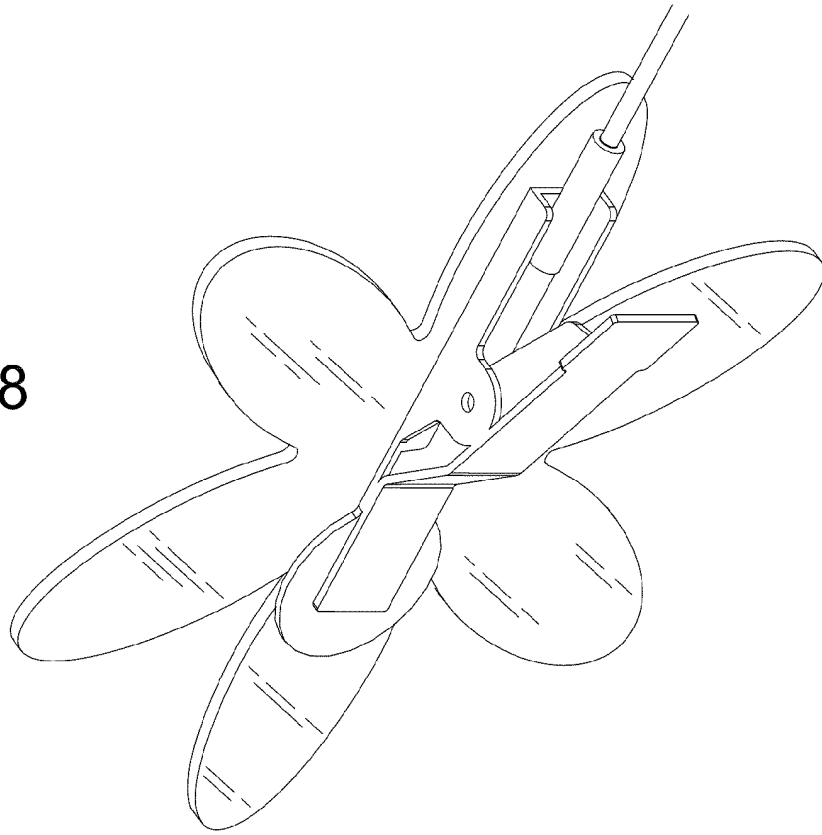
